Load-In/Parking

- Please arrive on-time to your agreed load-in time, allowing time for traffic and the train that blocks our driveway every hour. If you will be late, please call/text your on-site contact.
- Parking and load-in will be at the back of the venue through the door next to the loading dock. Please pull into the parking lot closest to the RR crossing and drive to the back and around to the left to access. There will be space reserved for up to 3 band vehicles in a coned-off lane to the right of the loading ramp area.
- **No loading in the main customer entrance please.**
- There is no ramp for stage access. There are a few small steps.
- We prefer for no band gear to go onstage until all monitors, mics, stands, and cabling has been set by our sound engineer
- The sound engineer will arrive at least 90 mins prior to show and will inform you when the stage is artist-ready.
- A line-check 15 minutes before your set is standard procedure. No full songs please. Your set can begin immediately or you could have a brief break before starting.
- A full sound check is negotiable. We are open for business prior to most shows. If you require one, they must be brief.
- There will be a dance floor and a tip jar provided at your request
- Approximate size of stage is 22' W X 10'8"

Backstage Policy

- Backstage space is limited to bands only. It is not a private green room space, however, it is a comfortable laid-back environment with seating, food & drink. There is a private bathroom.
- Your backstage area is within the brewery space. Brewing space access and wandering is absolutely prohibited for your safety, our employees' and customers' safety, and the safety and integrity of our beers. If you have questions about beer or the brewery please ask us. We like beer talk!
- No children are permitted back stage at any time

HOSPITALITY

- Your complimentary artist tab will include beer and pizza. Please note that band hospitality is limited to the band. All other guests are welcome to order and start a tab at the bar.
- Beer and water pitchers will be served to you backstage and placed on your band tab by your on-site

artist contact. Beer selection is at the discretion of the venue. If you do not drink beer, we can discuss limited wine, soft drinks, etc.

- Do not order drinks at the bar for your artist tab.
- Up to two 16" ABGB pizzas (cheese, calabrese or margherita; gluten-free options are available) will be served to you either prior to your set, during your set break, or after. Let us know your preference.
- Last call for the bar is 15 minutes before closing time for the night. We will provide you with post-show beverages, even if you are playing up to last call.
- Any other food orders are your responsibility and will not be discounted.

Load-Out / Payout

- Please clear the stage and load-out all equipment from the venue promptly after your set. We understand the desire to mingle and enjoy post-show beers, however please honor our venue hours and staff
- Payout will not occur until all artist gear is cleared from the venue .

PROMOTION

- We will post the show on our website and instagram. You are welcome to create a facebook event and tag us.
- Please provide us with your favored URL link and any information you would like to include (photos, videos, etc.).
- If you create a flier for your show, and we certainly hope you do, please give us a digital version and at least 10 copies of them- we will post them here.
